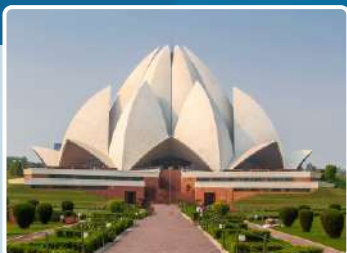

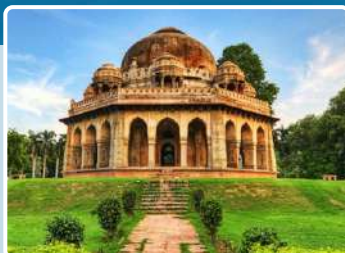
ABOUT DELHI

A Bahá'í House of Worship shaped like a lotus, it welcomes people of all faiths for meditation and peace.



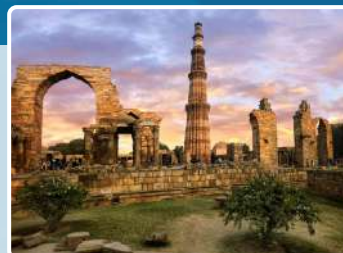
Lodhi Garden

A serene 90-acre park in New Delhi, dotted with stunning tombs and architectural relics.



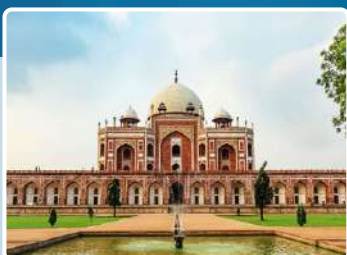
Red Fort

Commissioned by Empress Bega Begum, it's the first garden-tomb in India and a precursor to the Taj Mahal.



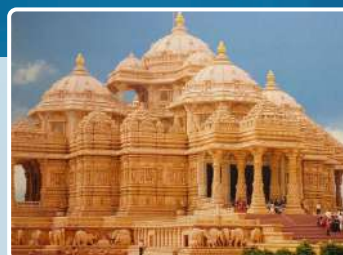
India Gate

A solemn war memorial honoring Indian soldiers who died in World War I, designed by Sir Edwin Lutyens.



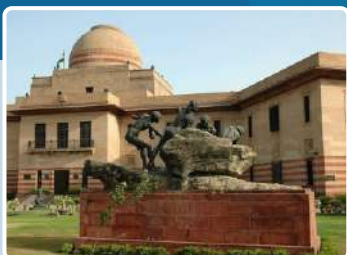
Jantar Mantar
